The deadline for your college applications is quickly approaching. All students applying to a Cal State and/or UC must have their applications completed and submitted by November 30, 2009. <u>Still need to take your SAT/ACT???</u>

Don't forget to sign up for your SAT and/or ACT!! Remember December is the last month to take either one of these exams. Two colleges have an earlier deadline, with Cal Poly San Luis Obispo's being October, and San Diego State's being November. To sign up for the December SATs (with a late fee) Go to www.collegeboard.com up to Friday, November 13th. Those of you applying to take the ACT must register for the exam no later than Friday, November 6th to avoid a late fee. To sign up for the ACT go to www.act.org. Stop by the guidance office to see if you are eligible for a fee waiver.

Applying to a UC?

When writing the Personal Statement make sure you answer the questions – Use details and examples. Write to add context and depth, not to fill space. Be you – Remember to talk about yourself so that they can get to know you and your potential to succeed at their school. Use plenty of "I" statements. If you missed our UC Application/personal Statement workshop on Oct 28, not to worry. UC has a video on writing the personal statement.
