Every Senior should be applying for financial aid to receive money to attend college, whether you plan on attending a community college, vocational school, or four-year college. It is important that you start the process early. All online applications are due by March 2, 2010. Here are a few important tips to remember in successfully completing your FAFSA application:



- Don't miss the deadline: Monday, March 2nd
- Remember to apply for your PIN as soon as possible at www.pin.ed.gov
- Get all necessary documents needed to begin the process
- Make sure your social security number is on file with Ms. Fitzrandolph (this is needed in order for us to send in your GPA verification

- * As our 1st semester is coming to an end, many of you will be receiving letters from colleges requesting that you send an updated transcript. It is very important that you come into the guidance office and see Mrs. Bhoot. She will have you fill out a "Transcript Request Form" and will make sure that your transcript is sent out once semester grades have been posted.
- * Those of you applying to private colleges don't forget to get your Mid-Year Reports completed and submitted before the deadlines. Remember to give your counselor enough notice to fill out the required forms.
- * If you happen to change your schedule for second semester you must remember to notify ALL campuses to which you have submitted an application. You should contact the admissions office either by email or telephone as soon as possible.

And lastly ... official SAT, ACT and/or SAT II scores must be sent to the campuses that you have submitted an application to. In order to do so simply access www.act.org. If you have any questions please stop by and see a counselor.



Credits for College Program

Those of you who would like to take a course for college credit should sign up for **Psychology 100—Introduction to Psychology** Fundamentals of human psychology. Using a scientific approach to the study of human behavior, this course examines and integrates physiological, intrapsychic, and social/behavioral perspectives on human thought and behavior.

WHAT ABOUT SCHOLARSHIPS?

Few scholarships will find their way to you. In the majority of cases you must look for them yourself. While many scholarships are available, their requirements vary greatly. Applying for scholarships takes work. Time has to be devoted to researching different kinds of scholarships. Not all scholarships require strong GPA's. Many scholarships require membership in service organizations or involvement in community and extracurricular activities. The trick is to find a scholarship that fits you.
