Many of you who are planning on attending a community college in the Fall of 2011 took the SOAR test here on campus. You will be receiving your test results in the mail within the next few weeks. Along with a copy of your results you will also receive information regarding New Student Orientation. It is important for you to attend the New Student Orientation because it will provide you with all the information that you need to start registering for your classes. We strongly encourage you to meet with an academic advisor once you have attended the New Student Orientation to make sure that you get started on the right track. Be sure to let the academic advisor know that you plan on transferring to a University after two years so that they can ensure you take all the appropriate classes.

For those of you who missed the SOAR test do not panic! Check the April issue of the Senior Newsletter for the schedule of make-up dates for both Golden West and Orange Coast colleges. If you would like to make an appointment to take the SOAR test at Golden West please call 714-895-8388 and for Orange Coast call 714-432-5696. Tests should be taken as soon as possible so that you receive your results and can register early for the appropriate classes.
